1. **UNDERGRADUATE SEMINARS**

TWO undergraduate seminars: History 393 and History 395. These seminars may be in any area and may double-count toward the required courses inside and outside of concentration, so long as the **total** number of distinct history courses still adds up to twelve.

4. **FURTHER REQUIREMENTS**

At least two of the twelve 200- and 300-level courses from Sections 1, 2, or 3 above must be in either Europe before 1800 OR Africa, Asia, Latin America, the Middle East (any period). *100-level classes may not be used to satisfy this requirement.*

NOTE: While any 393 or 395 seminar *may* count toward the six INSIDE CONCENTRATION courses (Section 2) OR the four additional OUTSIDE CONCENTRATION courses (Section 3), a student must take a total of at least 12 *different* history courses (titles) to fulfill the Major requirements. With the exception of those classes listed below, *all* of the classes applied to Sections 1, 2, and 3 above must originate in the History Department.

NOTE: Up to two of the following courses may be used to satisfy the requirements of Section 2 or 3, above:
(a) History courses taught in other departments or programs by regular faculty members of the History Department (e.g., Gender & Sexuality Studies 230-0 when taught by history faculty);
(b) *African American Studies* 212-1,-2 (combined with History 212-1,-2*); *Asian American Studies* 214-0 (combined with History 214-0*), 216-0 (combined with History 216-0*), 304-0 (combined with History 304-0*); *Classics* 211-0, 212-0, 321-0; *Economics* 315-0 (dependent upon subject matter), 318-0, 323-1,-2, 324-0; *Gender & Sexuality Studies* 324-0 (combined with History 324-0*); *Latino/a Studies* 218-0 (combined with History 218-0*); *Legal Studies* 318-1,-2 (combined with History 318-1,-2); *Religious Studies* 264-0, 265-0
**Combined classes* may be taken for credit in one department only and may not be taken for repeat credit in the other department offering the course.

NOTE: WCAS does not permit double-counting between the History major and other "stand-alone" majors; double-counting is only allowed in the case of an adjunct major and then only as prescribed by that adjunct major. The History major itself has no double-counting provision. Generally, there is no double-counting between majors and minors; see the WCAS website for the list of exceptions. Other schools in the university (Medill, McCormick, SoC) have their own double-counting rules. Please review these rules as necessary.
